- **Bloom & Grow Beautification:** On **Earth Day 2025**, Bloom & Grow Garden Society members gathered at Bay Pointe Apartments in Historic East Winter Garden to plant six Southern Live Oak trees, kicking off their **100 Trees for 100 Years** project. City leaders including Mayor John Rees, City Manager Jon Williams, and Commissioner Chloe Johnson joined the planting effort, alongside support from Ameriscapes Landscape Management,

Healthy West Orange, Duke Energy, and residents. A very special thank you to **Katy Moss** for championing this event and helping bring new life to our community!

- **Home Revitalization Progress:** Our Executive Board recently met with the City to discuss the launch of the **Legacy Fund Home Repair Program**, which will offer eligible East Winter Garden homes no less than **\$50,000** in repairs and renovations.
